The time has come once again to plan for the Seventh Annual Munson Community Heritage Festival at Krul Lake Recreation Area. Please allow me to take this opportunity to invite you to this special event. The idea of the Festival is to bring alive the history of the area, demonstrate the old time ways of the deep south as well as to promote culture in Santa Rosa County. There will be music, historical and cultural exhibits, demonstrations, arts, crafts, and food. The festival is scheduled for a one day event on October 9, 2010 from 9 am to 5 pm with time to set up displays beginning at 9 am on Friday October 8th. There will be a \$20.00 charge for vendors. For those exhibitors or vendors wanting to camp, there will not be a camping charge if space is available at Krul. Free camping will be available for Friday and Saturday night. Check out time on Sunday is 2 pm. Any camping not on Friday and Saturday will be by permission of the Division of Forestry and camping charges would apply.

Participants will be located around the lake and throughout the campgrounds. Shade is provided by some trees. If you want full protection from the sun or rain please bring a tent or awning for your exhibit.

Krul is a camping facility; the campgrounds will be closed to the general public for camping during the festival except for vendors and exhibitors who would like to camp.
